Code of Conduct

By agreeing to become a member of The Landseer Players, you not only agree to abide by the Constitution of The Landseer Players, but also to the Code of Conduct as described below.

1. If you are unable to attend a rehearsal, please inform the person who is running the rehearsal, giving as much notice as possible.
2. If you miss a significant number of rehearsals, you may be asked to step down from any part, or dance, that you may have been selected for.
3. Please take care of any song words, sheets of music or scripts that you are given. Bring them to all rehearsals – you never know when you may need them.
4. Dancers. Please do not wear jeans to rehearsals and bring trainers or jazz shoes / sneakers to dance in. Boots, or footwear with heels on them are not to be worn.
5. All cast must wear appropriate clothing at all times for rehearsals.
6. Principals, no scripts after Christmas.
7. Company members, no song words after Christmas.
8. Please arrive at rehearsals promptly. We aim to start at 7.30, unless otherwise stated.
9. Please treat all fellow members of the cast and production team with the same respect as you would wish to be treated with.
10. Only cast and crew, plus 1 chaperone, will be permitted in the rehearsal rooms.
11. Noise must be kept to a minimum during rehearsals. If your part of the rehearsal has finished, or you are not required for some time, and you wish to chat, please exit the room and use the Kitchen area.
12. During show week, you will be expected to be at ALL rehearsals.
